



This remarkable agreement signals the launch of the 'Agragaami' project, a collaborative effort that brings together the expertise of Saksham and the visionary Directorate of Higher Education of the Delhi Government. Supported by the generous backing of SBI Securities, this project is set to revolutionize the educational landscape for students with visual impairments in Delhi Government Schools.

Saksham takes immense pride in being a driving force behind this transformative endeavor, strengthening our unwavering commitment to inclusivity and accessible education. Together, we are not only breaking barriers but also shaping a future where every student has the opportunity to thrive and shine.

NEW BEGINNING FOR SAKSHAM'S RESIDENTIAL SCHOOL IN ROHRU, SHIMLA, HIMACHAL PRADESH







In an exciting collaboration with the CSR LIC Golden Jubilee Foundation, we are pleased to announce the progress in establishing a transformative "Education, Rehabilitation, and Resource Centre" in Rohru, Shimla, Himachal Pradesh. This initiative is set to address a critical service gap within the state by providing essential support to 20 children grappling with multiple disabilities and visual impairments. Our partnership aims to create a positive impact by enhancing the lives of these children and contributing to a more inclusive and supportive community.

The Bhoomi Poojan ceremony on June 20, 2023, marked a significant milestone for Saksham's Residential School in Shimla, signifying the commencement of a new chapter. The ceremony was honored by the presence of local MLA & CPS Himachal, Mr. Mohan Lal Brakta, and LIC's Sh. Keshav Shrivastava.

Phase II of our construction work faced its share of challenges, especially with adverse weather conditions briefly affecting our efforts. Nevertheless, we persevered and successfully completed the retention wall by October 11, 2023.

SAKSHAM ACCESSIBLE FILM FIESTA - CELEBRATING INCLUSIVITY THROUGH CINEMA







Our film fiesta featured audio-described movies that narrated visual elements. This inclusion enabled those with visual impairments to engage fully in the cinematic experience. Our commitment to promoting cultural accessibility extended to making cultural events, like film screenings, open and accessible to a wide and diverse audience, including those with disabilities.

The event was held across four different Delhi University colleges in the Delhi/NCR region and two special schools in Muzaffarpur and Jammu region, bringing the magic of cinema to diverse audiences.

Our event went beyond movies, offering hands-on experiences with Assistive Devices. We also introduced interactive Q&A sessions, enriching our mission of inclusivity.

Approximately 350 individuals with disabilities actively engaged in this event, making it a remarkable success.


CAMPAIGN: LEVERAGING SOCIAL MEDIA ACCESS ABILITY FOR ALL

Online Accessibility Campaign:

Our campaign, "Leveraging Social Media Accessibility for All," aims to ensure equal access to social media for users with disabilities, especially those with visual impairments. By promoting inclusive content, we seek to empower individuals and enhance engagement in the digital space.

The year-long project is divided into three phases, focusing on team onboarding, partnerships, and training workshops. Through these efforts, we aim to raise awareness and equip participants with the tools to create accessible content, fostering a more inclusive online community.





project significantly impacted accessibility for persons with disabilities (PwDs), reaching 7,000 PwDs through platforms like Eyeway and Radio Udaan. Influencers like Pragya Gupta garnered 6,847 YouTube views, while Instagram outreach connected with individuals. Sensitization workshops reached 2.500 people across 10 events. The creation of 15 accessible videos in five languages (Hindi, English, Punjabi, Bengali, Kannada) reached a total of 1,29,000 views, offering practical quidance making on content accessible. These efforts collectively raised awareness and promoted inclusivity, empowering both PwDs and mainstream society to adopt accessible practices, furthering the goal of a more inclusive environment.

- Our student Pranam achieved a significant milestone by qualifying for IIIT Kota, bringing immense pride to both himself and the Saksham community.



- We take great pride in sharing that our student Abhinav Bindra has been accepted into Symbiosis, Pune, a testament to his hard work and dedication.
- Abhinav Singh from our vocational unit has secured a job with the DS Group. The special educators of the vocational unit maintain regular communication with the senior staff to raise awareness and address any issues or queries that may arise.

Saksham launched a new initiative with a 3-month Home Management Girls Advanced Hostel Training Programme, enrolling five senior vocational unit girls: Arushi, Rupa, Nitish, Khushboo, and Riya. Throughout this advanced training, the students honed their skills in the following areas:







- Daily Living Skills
- Orientation and Mobility
- Organization and Labeling
- Sensory Skills
- Environmental Modification
- Food Preparation and Cooking Skills
- Clothing Care and Wardrobe Management
- Personal Hygiene Care
- Household Management and Housekeeping
- Time Management
- Shopping
- Social and Recreational Involvement

This training, which took place from January 2024 to March 2024, not only equipped these girls with essential skills but also provided valuable insights for us as an organization.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE SAKSHAM RESOURCE CENTRE

- We appreciate the generous support received from our sponsors, Transsion Holdings and Colorplast, which has been instrumental in advancing our initiatives.
- Our computer lab serves as a vital space where students develop proficiency in using computers, an essential tool for their writing, reading, and studies. This facility plays a crucial role in facilitating the enrollment of our students in mainstream schools. We extend our gratitude to Transsion Holdings for upgrading our computer lab with 21 standalone computers. Additionally, Transsion Holdings generously donated various swings for the Saksham playground, enhancing the recreational experience for our children.



- Saksham received 40 inquiries in the academic year 2023-2024, resulting in the enrollment of 30 students at the Saksham Resource Centre in Noida.
- Six of our children successfully transitioned into mainstream schools, marking a significant achievement in their educational journey.







- The year 2023-2024 saw remarkable interns and volunteers who significantly contributed to Saksham's ongoing efforts to create successful opportunities for people with disabilities.
- Kompal Paney deserves special recognition among the interns who joined us for research and training. Currently pursuing her Master's in Art Therapy from Symbiosis, Pune, she has enriched our approach toward individuals with disabilities. Throughout the year, we celebrated a variety of festivals and important occasions, embracing their significance and nurturing a strong sense of community. With joy and enthusiasm, we marked many events, including Republic Day, Holi, Eid, Independence Day, Raksha Bandhan, Janmashtami, Dussehra, Diwali, and Christmas.

Vocational Items stalls

The children in our vocational unit continuously develop skills to create handcrafted items suited to various Indian festivals. These items are sold year-round through stalls set up at our sponsor companies and, upon request, at community events hosted by our donors. This year, we showcased our vocational items during Navratri, Diwali, Christmas, and other occasions at venues like NOIDA Haat, HCL, MetLife, Microsoft, HDFC Bank, and PTI. Popular items included torans, latkans, festive bags, Christmas trees, hampers, and rakhis, all crafted with care and creativity by our students.



Braille Technology Development

Annie Lab:

Annie, a self-learning Braille literacy device that functions like a personal tutor, was introduced at Saksham through the establishment of an Annie Lab. This lab enables our students to gain proficiency in Braille reading and writing, supporting independent learning.

Tactile Library:

We also set up a dedicated tactile library to provide enhanced support for our students in their higher studies. This resource allows them to access educational materials more effectively, empowering them on their academic journeys.

Book Conversion Projects: A Year of Accessibility

Saksham Library had a remarkable year in 2023-24, successfully converting a significant number of pages into accessible EPUB 3.0 format. This achievement directly benefited a wide range of individuals, including students, competitive exam aspirants, and people with disabilities.



Direct End-User Requests:


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
JCB Prize Literature:

Saksham Library continued its partnership with the JCB Prize Literature, converting shortlisted and winning novels from the past five years. This year, five books were successfully converted into accessible format

Blind Students Support Group:

A dedicated WhatsApp group for blind competitive exam students was established to facilitate direct communication and understand their specific requirements. In response to these needs, 16,974 pages were converted into accessible format.





Aarohan Project at KMC, Delhi University:

A resource center was set up under the Arohan project to cater to the needs of blind students at KMC. 6,900 pages were converted to assist these students in their academic pursuits.

AMOGH Partnership:

A collaboration with AMOGH, an organization training individuals with disabilities in book conversion, resulted in the conversion of 66,626 pages.

HDFC-Supported State Board Textbooks:

In partnership with HDFC, Saksham Library converted state board textbooks from Assam, Manipur, and Mizoram. A total of 85 textbooks, comprising 15,473 pages, were made accessible.

ACCESSIBILITY AND IMPACT

All converted pages were uploaded to Sugamya Pustakalaya, a platform dedicated to accessible content. This ensures widespread accessibility and benefits individuals with visual impairments and other disabilities.

HELPLINES AND TRAINING

Saksham Library's helpline team received over 700 calls, providing valuable assistance and support to users. Additionally, training sessions on accessible book conversion and Sugamya Pustakalaya were conducted with organizations like Shubham and Manav Rachna School.

CONCLUSION

Saksham Library's efforts in 2023-24 have significantly contributed to making knowledge and education accessible to a wider audience. By addressing the specific needs of students, competitive exam aspirants, and individuals with disabilities, the library has played a vital role in promoting inclusivity and equal opportunities.

SAKSHAM SPORTS UNIT

Highlights:

- 1.In April 2023, visually impaired students participated in the **Under 19 Blind Cricket** tournament.
- 2. During the second week of April, three girls Anupama, Pari, and Savitri participated in the Chandigarh National Women's chess championship.
- 3.On June 4th, 2023, 15 players from Saksham participated in a **T20 Blind Cricket Match** at JNU.



4. In July, they took part in the **Delhi state chess championship** organized by DCBA (Delhi Chess Association for the Blind). It was one of the best performances by the Saksham Team. Ashwin Rajesh emerged as the winner and is now the Delhi State Champion. Ajith, Pari, Anupama, and Ashwin have qualified for the North Zone tournament for September 30th, 2023.







- 5. Anupama has been selected for the Delhi state women's cricket team during Women's Cricket Trials. From October 8th to 12th, Anupama participated in the interstate women's blind cricket tournament, where she was the youngest woman player in the Delhi team.
- 6. In November, Ashwin and Ajith represented Delhi in the Junior National Chess Championship held in Andhra Pradesh.

BRIDGING THE DIGITAL DIVIDE FOR PERSONS WITH VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

According to the 2011 census, a significant number of visually impaired individuals reside in Odisha and Jharkhand, contributing to a substantial economic burden. While advancements in assistive technology have positively impacted many, millions remain excluded due to poverty and limited access to these resources.

Traditional education methods have proven insufficient, leading to high rates of illiteracy and unemployment among the visually impaired. Outreach efforts and device distribution alone are not enough, as configuring devices and addressing affordability challenges remain obstacles.

To address these issues, the Jyoti Gamya program was established to support digital inclusion and equity for visually impaired individuals in underserved areas. Through collaboration with Saksham, Assistech Lab of IIT Delhi, and Sabal, the program leverages technology to improve the lives of visually impaired people and promote their inclusion in society.

JYOTIR GAMYA PROGRAM

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- Capacity Building: Trained 5 Saksham Sabal Champions in Odisha and 74 Saksham Sabal Citizens in both states to become advocates and facilitators for digital inclusion.
- Community Outreach: Expanded the Aarthi network to include 183 members in Odisha and 206 in Jharkhand, ensuring wider reach and impact.
- Assistive Technology Distribution: Provided 21 ITel 23 smartphones and Bluetooth keyboards on subsidy in Jharkhand, enabling greater accessibility and independence.
- Network Development: Organized special school and district-level meetings to strengthen partnerships and expand the program's reach.



PROGRAM IMPACT

- Empowered Individuals: Enabled visually impaired individuals to acquire essential digital skills, access information, and participate more fully in society, fostering greater independence and inclusion.
- Enhanced Quality of Life: Improved the overall well-being of program beneficiaries through increased independence, social connection, and economic opportunities, leading to a more fulfilling and satisfying life.
- Community Development: Strengthened local communities by fostering a culture of inclusion and support for individuals with disabilities, promoting a more equitable and compassionate society.

FUTURE PLANS

- Expansion: Continue to expand the Aarthi network to reach 800 individuals in both states by the end of August 2024, ensuring wider access and impact.
- Technology Integration: Introduce a user-friendly mobile app to provide additional resources, facilitate community engagement, and enhance accessibility for program beneficiaries.
- Sustainability: Explore sustainable funding mechanisms and partnerships to ensure the long-term viability of the program and its continued impact on the target communities.

CONCLUSION

The Jyotir Gamya program has significantly impacted the lives of visually impaired individuals in Odisha and Jharkhand. By providing comprehensive support, including assistive technology and training, the program has narrowed the digital divide and improved overall well-being. Moving forward, we remain dedicated to expanding our reach, enhancing our services, and fostering a more inclusive society for all.

Sensitisation drive at HMV College, Punjab 1st April 2023

Saksham organised a Sensitization Drive at HMV College, introducing college students to the processes involved in eBook production and the devices used by visually impaired individuals. The event attracted over 150 students, many of whom showed interest in contributing to eBook production.



Sensitisation workshop at MGN Public School, Jalandhar, Punjab 30th May, 2023

Saksham organized a sensitization workshop at MGN Public School in Jalandhar, Punjab, aiming to raise awareness about the skills and knowledge needed for self-sufficient computer-based reading and writing among students with visual impairments. Nearly 100 students and teachers participated in the interactive activities and demonstrations held during the session.

Sensitisation workshop at TCLP, Delhi 3rd July, 2023

A sensitization workshop was held for the staff members of The Community Library Project (TCLP) to raise awareness about the challenges faced by people with visual impairments and how these challenges can be addressed using various assistive technologies (AT) solutions. During the workshop, participants were blindfolded and given a firsthand experience using assistive solutions for reading, writing, and performing other daily activities.



Tandem Cycling Rally for Accessible Social Media in Punjab 27th August 2023

Lovely Professional University in Punjab hosted a tandem cycling rally to advocate for accessible social media, underlining their commitment to an inclusive digital space. Over 100 participants, including students and individuals with and without disabilities, rode side-by-side, holding signs with tips and messages promoting accessible social media.





Webinar on Career Opportunities in the teaching Sector for Persons with Visual Impairment
18th August 2023

This session was conducted as part of the series of career awareness workshops held for students pursuing higher education and aspiring professionals to make them aware about the opportunities and required skills for pursuing their career in this sector

Awareness workshop in Khairpur, UP 4th September 2023

A workshop was held at composite school in Khairpur village, Gautam Buddh Nagar, for the principal and all teachers. Saksham's special educators trained the teachers on various screening techniques and teaching strategies for students with diverse disabilities. The workshop also showcased Teaching Learning Materials (TLM) developed by Saksham specifically for students with disabilities (PWD).



Workshop with teachers & special educators in Gautam Buddh Nagar, UP 29th September 2023

A workshop was conducted to equip principals, special educators from mainstream schools in Gautam Buddh Nagar district, and representatives from local education organizations with strategies to address the educational and related needs of students with disabilities. The workshop explored commonly available tools and technologies that teachers can utilize in their classrooms, contributing to a more inclusive and accessible learning environment.



Awareness Workshop on workplace solutions with SBI, Delhi 5th October 2023

A workshop empowered visually impaired employees of SBI from the Delhi region by introducing them to various workplace solutions that can enhance their efficiency and independence. The session demonstrated technologies for creating an accessible office environment, accessing printed documents, and using navigation aids.

Awareness Session on workplace solutions with Bank of Baroda, Delhi 6th October 2023

An online session for visually impaired staff members of Bank of Baroda equipped them with knowledge about workplace solutions to enhance their efficiency and independence. The session covered technologies for creating an accessible office environment, accessing printed documents, and using navigation aids.



Right to Write Computer Speed and

Accuracy Competition at HCL, Noida 30th November 2023

A national computer typing competition for visually impaired students was held in November. Students from special and inclusive schools across India participated. The competition aimed to promote technology use among students with blindness and provide a platform to showcase their skills. It also aimed to raise awareness about the independence technology can bring in reading, writing, and education. Participants used dictation from sighted volunteers to complete a designated script with speed and accuracy. The event drew enthusiastic participation from students, parents, teachers, peers, and representatives from corporate institutions like HCL.





Education Pavilion at Purple Fest Goa 8th January to 13th January 2024

Saksham set up an education pavilion at Purple major disability awareness event organized by the Goa state government. Four NGOs supporting people with various disabilities showcased methods and resources promoting inclusive education. The pavilion officials, attracted government students, teachers, educators from special and mainstream schools and colleges, and representatives from various NGOs.

Inclusive games arena at Purple Fest Goa

8th January to 13th January 2024

Inclusive car rally in Goa 13th January 2024

Saksham hosted a unique car rally in Goa, featuring 25 teams with visually impaired navigators guiding sighted drivers along the route. Designed as an inclusive motorsport event, the rally achieved remarkable success, garnering significant attention for its innovative combination of competition and inclusivity.

Inclusive Games at Kirori Mal College 15th February 2024

Saksham, in collaboration with the Centre for Disability Research and Training and Kirori Mal College's enabling unit, organized a sensitization event at Delhi University's Kirori Mal College. The event featured an experience zone and various inclusive games, fostering participation between students with and without disabilities. This interaction allowed students to gain a deeper understanding of inclusion.




Awareness and sensitisation workshop in Mizoram

22nd February 2024

Saksham, along with the Mizoram Blind Society and the State Council Educational Research and **Training** (SCERT) Mizoram government. organized a one-day awareness and sensitization workshop students for pursuing bachelor's degrees in special education for hearing visual and impairments. Following an overview of various assistive technologies, participants engaged in a series of blindfolded activities, gaining firsthand experience with the challenges faced by visually impaired individuals.







Over 3,000 people gained a deeper understanding of assistive technology for persons with visual impairments through our awareness workshops.

Training on fundamental computer applications at Khalsa College, Delhi University 10th February to 20th April 2023

Saksham organized a training program for visually impaired students at Shri Guru Nanak Dev Khalsa College, Delhi University. The program focused on fundamental computer applications, including MS Office, internet navigation, and tools for reading and downloading ebooks. This training empowers students to perform their reading and writing tasks independently.





Training on navigation and workplace solutions at American India Foundation 3rd May 2023


Training on Creation of Accessible Content at JDMC College, Delhi University 16th to 18th May 2023

A 3-day workshop equipped Janki Devi Memorial College's library and enabling unit staff with the skills and knowledge to convert learning materials into accessible formats. This will enable students with print disabilities to access course content independently using assistive technologies.



Online Training on android tablet 5th to 7th June 2023

A 3-day training was held for school and college students from Lucknow region on using android tablet. This training mainly focused on key gestures of talkback, assistive applications for reading and writing that can be used on the tab, and using the tab with a bluetooth keyboard so that it can be used by the students as the note taking device as well.






Training on reading devices in Kasganj, UP 5th to 8th June 2023

Following needs assessments based on age and occupation, the program, supported by the Nagrota Welfare Society, concluded by equipping each participant with a personalized assistive technology kit.

Training workshop for latest assistive solutions for reading and writing in Bihar 22nd to 23rd August 2023

Saksham organized a 2-day training workshop at Shubham Viklang Vikas Sansthan, a special school in Muzaffarpur, Bihar.


Day one focused on equipping teachers with methods to create accessible digital learning materials for their students. Day two included an awareness and training session for both teachers and students on the latest assistive technologies for independent reading and writing by students with blindness. To encourage technology use, the day concluded with a computer speed and accuracy competition.



Training on Assistive Solutions for Education in Jammu 24th September 2023

Saksham organized a training workshop on September 24th, 2023, at Louis Braille Memorial Residential School for the Sightless Girls in Roop Nagar, Jammu. This workshop was part of a 2-day Tek Fiesta organized in Jammu in collaboration with the J&K Handicapped Association and the National Federation for the Blind J&K. The workshop equipped participants with essential skills for using computers and Android devices with screen readers, as well as accessing printed materials using the URead assistive device. Students from area special schools, visually challenged college students, and teachers actively participated in the training. The program also featured engaging competitions to assess learning and promote technology use. These competitions included the Right to Write computer typing speed and accuracy competition and an assistive technology quiz.





Training workshop on assistive devices for education in Kasganj, UP 29th to 30th September 2023



Training on android devices in Chhattisgarh 13th to 18th February 2024

Between 13th to 18th February 2024, a series of training workshops were held across 3 special schools in Chhattisgarh, namely Saksham Awasi Vidyalaya in Gariaband, Nayandeep Vidya Mandir in Bhilai and Awasi Prashikshan Kendra in Kachandur district. The training was held for a period of 2 days in each school wherein the students with visual impairment were taught the use of android tablet with Bluetooth keyboard for the purpose of reading their books and writing their notes and assignments. A total of 41 students from these schools were also provided with tab with keyboard.

Training of trainers in Manipur 6th March 2024

An online training session was held with 6 visually challenged students of Manipur. These individuals will serve as the local trainers and further train the students who face any issues or challenges in using android devices in the long run.



Trainers' training workshop in Jaipur

A 3-day trainers' training workshop was held with teachers and special educators of RNKS, which is an organisation working with students and individuals with blindness in Jaipur.
